Reactivate Online Banking Connection in Quicken for Mac

This document provides action needed and step by step instructions on how to connect your accounts to the updated connection within Quicken for Mac.

1. Create a Quicken data file backup: go to File menu >Save a Backup



2. To check for updates: go to Quicken >Check for Updates

- 4. Go to Accounts menu >Settings:



5. Select Set up transaction download, then select Show financial institution.
